Trent Hall Updates



BEMANCO obtained a grant from the State of Maryland to replace the pier at Trent Hall Creek.

We were awarded this money for the sole purpose of replacing the existing pier at Trent Hall because it had become such a safety hazard.

We are grateful to the office of Senator Jack Bailey for his help and support in this grant being awarded to us. Coastal Enterprises did great work and we are happy to recommend their services. A dedication ceremony was held in honor of the many years of effort and volunteering given by Mrs. Doris Hodges to our community.

Approximately thirty shrubs and trees were donated by one of our residents and installed at this site while another resident regraded the entire parking area to ensure proper drainage.

Property Updates

Amazing volunteers have been busy!

Benson's also received a bit of a facelift in 2023! New lights and poles have been replaced by SMECO. We were also able to increase parking by removing old poles and moving an existing light pole to a different spot. This should help on busy summer weekends.

At **Long Point** an 8' fire pit was installed for community bonfires. The blocks and labor were donated by volunteers for all to enjoy! A large tree was trimmed in preparation to have topsoil dumped to fill low lying areas.



Small Beach parking lot has had new millings spread & graded along with additional, donated shrubs placed. The generosity of a neighbor has allowed us to accumulate new pilings to replace the old ones along the parking lot. We are researching fundraising, grant opportunities & equipment sales for the playground.

Unfortunately, a recent storm and tidal surge caused severe damage to the fishing pier at this site and we have had to temporarily close access to the pier. We are looking for a neighbor with a small boat we can work from, a semi-warm sunny weekend, and some time to make necessary repairs to this pier to allow us to reopen for spring fishing and crabbing!

Bylaw Amendments

Times are changing & BEMANCO is evolving to meet the needs of the community.

In our September 2023 meeting we discussed the need to update some of the current Bylaws of BEMANCO. These Bylaws were last updated in November of 1992. The following Bylaw Amendments were presented at both the October Meeting and on our web page for review by the community.

We had an additional open meeting in November for members of the community to vote in person and by Proxy. We are pleased to announce that we had more than enough members of the community represented in person, or by proxy, to constitute a quorum and that all of the following Amendments were voted on and approved.

Important changes to note:

- Visitors Passes are increasing to \$5 per day for vehicles and \$15 per day for trailers
- Officer Terms are now 3 years
- 2 additional Board Member positions have been added
- Electronic media used a means of communication
- Beach Sticker requests after June 15th will incur a \$5 convenience fee
- Documents requested for settlements will be charged a \$25 fee
